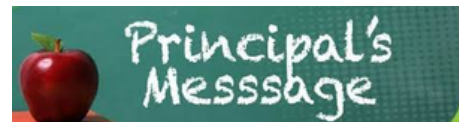
Lost & Found

Dear Greendale Parents,

As we entering the month of May we are needing parents help in a number of important areas.

- Please remind your child if they are walking home at the end of the day they should start doing this right at the dismissal bell. We ask that students not remain on the school grounds to play unless a parents or guardian is there to supervise them.
- Supervision in the morning starts at 7:45am unless children arrive on an early bus. We ask that students arrive at the school no earlier than 7:45 unless they are on the bus.
- Between 11:45 and 12:15 there is limited staff at the office. As such we would request that parents connect with the office before this time if they are needing to drop food off for lunch or sign out their child. During lunch if parents are needing to drop off food for their child please label the items and leave them at the office. We will work to ensure these items are brought to your child.

Our SD33 BASC programs employ certified Education Assistants to provide before and after school care. This inclusive care program is designed to provide a comforting environment for our students before and after school. We offer daily outdoor play, planned activities, art & crafts and more.

Not only is it convenient for parents to have school and care in one location, Early Childhood Educators, Education Assistants and our Primary teachers have a shared philosophy of learning, using B.C.'s Early Learning Framework as their guide.

- Kindergarten: \$222
- Grades 1 to 5: \$ 427
- The fees listed above reflect the savings provided through the Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative, without CCFRI, the full monthly fee would be \$542
- Eligible families may apply for the **BC Affordable Child Care Benefit Subsidy** to assist with Child Care fees.
